



2023 Huni Kuin Yube Inu Festival

(April 15th – 25th, 2023)

The Huni Kuin Yube Inu Festival is an annual gathering of the Huni Kuin people of the Jordan River, organized by the leaders of the Yube Inu Institute and its non-indigenous partners.

Your destination is Aldeia Boa Vista, Kaxinawá Indigenous Land on the upper Jordão River, in the state of Acre, Brazil. To participate, you are invited to register with the organization, in accordance with the determinations of local leaders and current legislation, and to contribute to the festival.

This is a community-based project, with the participation of local leaders and communities, and is not considered a tourist package. For our part, we organize your arrival, build the structures and coordinate with local companies the necessary services to co-create a bridge between you and the forest.

What's included:

- River transport by canoe: Jordão/Aldeia Boa Vista/Jordão;
- Accommodation in collective houses in the village for the participants;
- 3 daily meals with traditional dishes offered during the 10 days of the festival;
- Potable water;
- Participation in all festival activities;
- Assistance of bilingual and indigenous guides throughout the trip;

What is not included:

- International or domestic flights to Rio Branco, Acre, Brazil;
- Air taxi from Tarauca - Jordão - Tarauca;
- Transfer between Rio Branco – Tarauca – Rio Branco
- Hotel and meals in Rio Branco or additional ones in Jordão;
- Adventure Kit: hammock with mosquito net, sleeping bag, etc;
- Personal items, food supplements, etc;
- Travel insurance;
- Items not specified above.

Exchange Amount: \$2,000

Obs.1: Your place is guaranteed only after depositing 50% of the total amount. The remaining 50% is paid in cash on arrival.

Obs.2: Payment by credit card only through EventBrite (fee already included)
